Liter of Light

- It is an open source design for a low-cost light tube that refracts solar light to provide daytime interior lighting for dwellings with thin roofs.
- Since 2011, it has been reducing pollution by transforming plastic bottles into light sources.
- Over the years, it has brought the green "power" to millions of people in rural villages worldwide and reused thousands of bottles.
- In 2018, the volunteer-run organization aspires to reach one million homes.
